Airfield Access to the Kettle Lakes for Mobility-Impaired Fishermen

The DBIDS card you receive from the USAFA Pass and Registration Center only provides access through the airfield's electronic gate (K1) at the intersection of Airfield Drive and South Gate Boulevard. Your card will expire one year from the date of issue, but can be renewed by the Natural Resources staff.

Instructions:

Hold your DBIDS card <u>over</u> the black card reader at the gate.



- Pass through the gate and allow it to close fully. If someone behind you triggers the gate, you can release control of the gate to them and proceed.
- Stay on Airfield Drive **Do Not Stop or Park** until to reach the Kettle Lakes parking area at the sharp curve in the road. From the parking area you can access the roads around the lakes as shown below. Please park where you will not obstruct other traffic.



• When exiting the airfield, the outbound gate will automatically open as you slowly approach. Pass through the gate and allow it to close fully. If someone comes up behind you, you can release control of the gate to them and proceed.
