

## **ROOKIE SPORTSMAN PROGRAM**

The Rookie Sportsman Program (RSP) is designed to take families or individuals that have never hunted before, pair them with a Wildlife Officer mentor, and expose them to the world of hunting in Colorado over the course of the yearlong program. Although the focus of the program is hunting, there are also opportunities to learn how to fish and experience other outdoor skills. Each family or individual will have a Wildlife Officer as their mentor over the course of the program, as well as experienced hunt masters assisting with some of the hunts. You do not need equipment, firearms or gear to get started in the RSP.

The RSP starts in March with a Hunter Education class and ends in January with a banquet hosted by the RSP families. The Hunter Education class is just for the participants of the program and is designed to provide more time for discussion and questions. There are classes planned at least once a month from March through the end of January. Sometimes these are organized events such as the hunter education class, overnight events like a dove hunt, and other times they are day hunts with one of your mentors. Participants are expected to make the majority of these opportunities, although you can pick and choose events to meet your specific interests. In addition to the time required, there is a financial consideration as well. Although participants will have the opportunity to borrow firearms (shotguns, rifles and archery equipment), most find that they begin buying equipment during the course of the class. You will also need to purchase the required licenses for the species you are interested in hunting. Occasionally there may also be fees for camping or entrance to state parks.
